- 1. The Council Of Deliberation England would like to proudly announce that we are now accepting applications for the third year running for our scholarship award programme. The awards given out this year will be in 5 categories as follows:
- 1 Scholarship for \$1000.00
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- 2 additional Scholarships for \$500.00 each.
- 2. The criteria is established as follows:
  - a) Student Status
    - 1. Must be enrolled on a permanent full time basis, or a permanent parttime basis
    - 2. With the exception of a few mandatory courses you must not be on a secondary degree course
    - 3. Age of 18 years old and above (17 years old if entering college)
  - b) School Grades
    - 1. An American grade point average of 3.5, or
    - 2. An equivalent GCSE at 'A' Level, grade "C" or above
    - 3. Mature students will not have to meet the above criteria
  - c) Type of College/University/School
    Any accredited college, university, or NVQ Level "2"

## 3. Full Completion of the Scholarship Application Form Including a Copy of Transcript is Mandatory.

The school transcript must accompany the application and entire package should then be forwarded directly to the Council of Deliberation Chairman or one of the local Scottish Rite representatives. Any Incomplete, late or applications that fails to meet the above criteria will be excluded.

**NOTE:** All applications can either be mailed/posted or sent electronically (email) to either the chair/deputies chairs or local Masonic representative, but must have a postmark or time-date stamp of no later than Friday 10 July 2009.

The final 5 finalists will be notified by telephone no later than Wednesday 15 May 2009. The 5 finalists or their representative will be expected to attend the Ball, where each will be presented with their individual scholarship award. All ticket/s for family and friends can be purchased through your local Masonic representative.

The Ball will take place at 1930 hours, on Saturday, 25 July 2009, at RAF Croughton.
